Tax Policies

Responsibility for Taxes

You are responsible for identifying your Tax obligations in addition to the calculation, remittance, and reporting of all taxes within your obligation.

In some circumstances, SpaceApp Holdings Inc, may, consistent with the applicable law, calculate, collect, and remit (as SpaceApp) applicable national, state, or local sales and use taxes, goods, and services taxes, or value added taxes (collectively "Taxes") on orders destined to specific locations.

SpaceApp Holdings Inc does not report or remit Taxes to any government on behalf of any seller. Sellers remain responsible for any ongoing remittance and/or reporting requirements they may have in connection with SpaceApp.org Service.

Except as otherwise provided in the SpaceApp Holdings Inc Business Service Agreement (the "Agreement"), you agree that SpaceApp Holdings Inc is not obligated to determine your tax obligation, whether taxes apply, and SpaceApp Holdings Inc will not be responsible to calculate, collect, report, or remit any seller obligated taxes arising from any transaction. However, if a taxing authority requires us to pay any of your taxes, you will promptly reimburse us for the amount paid.

Taxes on Fees and Payments

All fees payable by you pursuant to this Agreement are exclusive of all taxes, and you will pay any taxes that are imposed and payable on such amounts. All payments made by you SpaceApp Holdings Inc under this Agreement will be made free and clear of any deduction or withholding (including but not limited to cross-border withholding taxes), as may be required by law. If any such deduction or withholding is required on any payment, you will pay such additional amounts, as are necessary so that the net amount received by SpaceApp Holdings Inc is equal to the amount then due and payable under this Agreement.

Shipping Products Internationally

When fulfilling product from a country outside the order origin country (elected country), you are the importer of goods to the elected country and responsible for the payment of all import duties, taxes, and custom fees (collectively "Customs Fees"). If you fulfill product to an address outside your elected country, generally, you are considered the exporter, and the buyer is considered the importer. The seller is responsible for export Customs Fees (if any) and the buyer is responsible for any import Customs Fees related to their purchase. Customs Fees paid by any party (if any) are in addition to the sales proceeds collected by SpaceApp.org.

How Tax is calculated

The amount of tax charged on your order depends on many factors including the following:

- a. The identity of the seller
- b. The type of item or service purchased.
- c. The time and location of fulfillment

d. The shipment or delivery address of your order

These factors can change between the time you place an order and when your shipment is complete. As a result, the tax calculated on your order may change. We display an "Estimated Tax" to be collected at Check Out when confirming an order. The amounts displayed as estimated tax may then be updated later when your order is finalized and completed.

The tax rate applied to your order will be the combined state and local rates of the address where your order is delivered to or fulfilled from. For example, if you live in a state that does not impose a sales tax, you may still see tax calculated on your order if shipped to another state. Moreover, the tax rates applied to your order may also be different for a variety of reasons, such as a shipment to a residential home versus a business address. Also, the total selling price of an item will generally include item-level shipping and handling charges, item level discounts, and other charges. If applied at an order level, these charges may be allocated to the individual items in an order.

If you are ordering from SpaceApp Holdings Inc and shipping to a country outside of the US, you may be charged the applicable country tax rate.
